

CONTINUE YOUR PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP

Once a person gives their life to the Lord Jesus, as Savior, they enter into a personal relationship with God The Father. In John 14:6 Jesus says "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." This experience with Jesus as Savior may be referred to as *being saved; born again* or *redeemed*. But it is only the beginning of a life in a personal way with God.

I want to emphasize the *beginning* in the relationship. This personal encounter isn't the end of this new and right relationship. As believers, saved by grace through this personal experience, we must continue to walk in this personal relationship.

God is calling *the saved* to serve. Calling to us that we would draw even closer to Him. He wants to have an ongoing personal relationship that grows with time. I call this spiritual growth. When we believers have a personal relationship, it is then we really *know* the Lord. The word *know* denotes a personal relationship, intimate and close encounter.

Only when a person becomes *personal* in a relationship with the Lord, can He truly speak to them and use them.

My point of saying all of this is that many of we Christians haven't yet known the Lord (1 Samuel 3:7) to where we recognize His voice when He does call to us. Read the story of the Lord calling Samuel, in 1 Samuel the 3rd chapter. We know Him as the one we gave our life to, one who we serve and one we love, but need to grow into a more *personal relationship* with HIM

to continue your personal relationship with your Lord so He can use you more affectively in your Christian walk.

I challenge you to continue your personal relationship with JESUS! Grow spiritually and watch how He will use you.
